1st Saturday, 14th September 2019 Village Open Day – suggestions include St Marys (including belltower tours, mini flower festival and teas), Church Paddock, Winchester Golf Academy, Motocross on Down Farm Lane, Farms, Pubs and/or WSSC bar area, Woodhams Farm Nursery, Woodhams Farm Stables, Princes Mead School, Kings Worthy Primary woodland area, Police building on Court Road (probably just a police vehicle or two in front?), Worthy Down (this would probably need some kind of shuttle bus arrangement, ?? from the Army themselves, or consider asking Princes Mead re their minibuses, Scout Hut, Show Homes at Kings Barton, Wildflower meadow ecological walk – all to consider alternatives
